## Building the foundation: Canadian firefighters powering the future of cancer research




As wildfires continue to devastate large swaths of Canada, conversations about frontline safety and long-term health are once again making headlines. But for those working in fire halls year-round, the risks have never been seasonal. Firefighters face a higher burden of chronic disease, particularly cancer, and are often underrepresented in long-term health research.

That's why <u>Healthy Future Sask (HFS)</u>, Saskatchewan's regional cohort of the Canadian Partnership for Tomorrow's Health (CanPath), launched a focused recruitment effort in partnership with the <u>Saskatoon Fire Department</u> earlier this year.





- Saskatchewan supported by a \$40K Health Canada commitment to continue expanding firefighter recruitment
- Strengthening evidence on occupational exposures and cancer risk, informing prevention and policy




#### Follow-up studies - OHS example

- The OHS Follow-Up Questionnaire 2 collects similar data at multiple timepoints, which allows researchers to track how participants' health changes over time
- Fills in gaps: new sections to complete that focus on your mental health and wellbeing, as well as your access to healthcare
- 27,422 completed questionnaires as of Nov. 10, 2025. Early results below:

Screening, cancer outcomes (e.g., recall, biopsy rates, stage at diagnosis), and cancer treatments





- Brain, carotid, abdomen, and cardiac MRIs (4 scans/participant)
